Formalization rules for the scientific work

- 1. Work size up to 15 pages;
- 2. attached figures must be presented on a standard size sheet (A4);
- 3. font Times New Roman, size 12 pt., line spacing 1,5 cm, paragraph indent 1,25 cm;
- 4. page fields: top, bottom, right -2 cm, left -3 cm;
- 5. pagination centre, bottom. Title page without number, next page number 2;
- 6. figure numbering continuous, centre, 12 pt., line spacing 1cm;
- 7. text must have literature reference.

Scientific work includes:

- 1. annotation (title of the work, universal decimal classification, university name, year of completing of the work, size of the work, number of appendixes, number of figures, number of tables, number of literary source);
- 2. contents (sections and subsections, consistently);
- 3. main body (topic of research and its conditions at the present time, relevance and targets, method of research, results and technical and economic or social and economic efficiency);
- 4. conclusion (main points and recommendations);
- 5. appendix (auxiliary materials).
